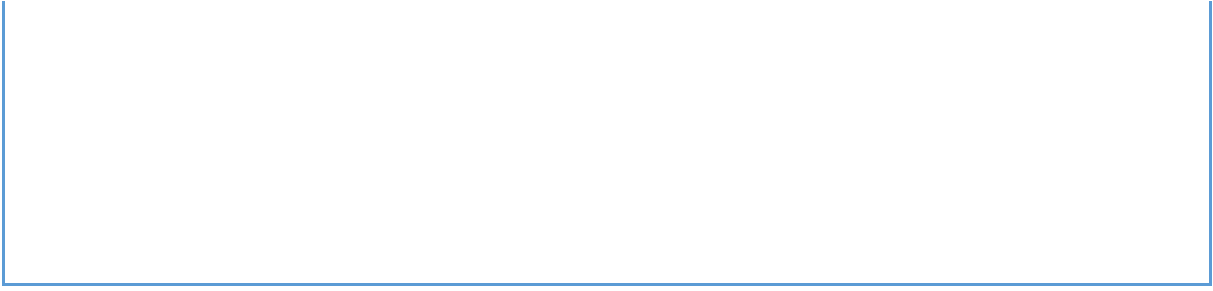

6.3 Coach	<p>⇒ Admission is free for one coach per 5 competitors.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - of 1 to 5 : 1 coach - of 6 to 10 : 2 coaches - of 11 to 15 : 3 coaches - ... <p>⇒ Each additional coach costs 5 €.</p> <p>⇒ The coach must be in sportswear to coach NOT IN DOBOK.</p> <p>⇒ The coach must be over 18 years old.</p> <p>⇒ He must be in possession of his identity card or his passport.</p> <p>⇒ From 01/01/2015, the coaches of the ABFT must be in possession of their coach card for the Belgians</p> <p>⇒ The coach must be in possession of his insurance license 2017.</p>
