<u>Note:</u> Timings may be subject to changes by the competition director depending on the competition progress.				
3.4 Fighting areas	5 or 6 fighting areas equipped with electronic score boards.			
3.5 Electronic body protectors	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- <b>Daedo GEN 2</b> electronic body protectors will be used for all categories. Electronic head protectors will be used for categories where head kicks are allowed.</li><li>- All competitors must provide their own Daedo electronic sensor socks.</li><li>- Competitors from categories where head kicks are not allowed must provide their own head protector.</li></ul>			
3.6 Invidividual Awards	<p>The 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> of each category will be awarded with a gold, silver and bronze medal respectively.</p> <p>Medals will be awarded at the end of each fight.</p> <p>Three trophies will be awarded:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Fair-play trophy (club)</li><li>- Best referee trophy</li><li>- Best fighter trophy</li></ul>			
3.7 Team Awards	<p>Top 5 teams will be awarded a trophy.</p> <p>Points for the final team ranking will be awarded as follows:</p> <p>7 points per gold medal</p> <p>3 points per silver medal</p> <p>1 point per bronze medal</p> <p>In the event of a tie, the ranking will be determined by the number of gold, silver and bronze medals won by each club. In case of a new tie, the ranking will be determined by the number of competitors per club. As a last resort, the club that has earned the most points in the +87 kg category will be declared the winner (WT rules).</p>			

## 4. Competitors

### 4.1 Age Categories

Pee wees	9-11	Born in 2011, 2010 and 2009
Cadets	12-14	Born in 2008, 2007 et 2006
Juniors	15-17	Born in 2005, 2004 et 2003
Seniors	17+	Born in 2003 and before

Note:

- If a contestant is the only competitor in their category, no changes in age category will be allowed, neither during registration nor on competition day.

### 4.2 Grades

C-Class	8 <sup>th</sup> to 5 <sup>th</sup> keup
AB-Class	From 4 <sup>th</sup> keup

Note:

- C-Class competitors will not be allowed to move up in grade category, neither during registration nor on competition day
- AB-Class competitors will not be allowed to go down in grade category, neither during registration nor on competition day

### 4.3 Weight divisions

Pee Wee (female/male):	-24, -27, -30, -33, -36, -40, -44, -48, 52, + 52kg
Cadets (female):	-29, -33, -37, -41, -44, -47, -51, -55, -59, +59kg
Cadets (male):	-33, -37, -41, -45, -49, -53, -57, -61, -65, +65kg
Junior (female):	-42, -44, -46, -49, -52, -55, -59, -63, -68, +68kg
Juniors (male):	-45, -48, -51, -55, -59, -63, -68, -73, -78, +78kg
Seniors (female):	-46, -49, -53, -57, -62, -67, -73, +73
Seniors (male):	-54, -58, -63, -68, -74, -80, -87, +87

- Pee wees, cadets and juniors will be allowed to move up only 1 weight division if they are the only competitor in their division. This can be requested by the coach only.

### 4.4 Head kicks

- ⇒ Head kicks are NOT allowed for all Pee wees and C-class cadets.
- ⇒ Head kicks are allowed for all AB-class cadets as well as for all juniors and seniors.

### 4.5 Weigh-in

- ⇒ A 99-gram excess will be tolerated during weigh-in.

Example :

- A competitor weighing 58,0 kg will compete in the -58 kg division.
- A competitor weighing 58,1 kg will compete in the -63 kg division.

## 6 RESPONSIBILITY

<b>6.1 Federation</b>	
<b>6.2 Competitors</b>	<p>⇒ All competitors must be in possession of their 2020 license and insurance</p> <p>⇒ All competitors must be in possession of a valid ID card or passport.</p> <p>⇒ All competitors enter the competition at their own risk.</p> <p>⇒ The organising club and ABFT decline any responsibility in the event of physical damage, violent behavior, injury or theft.</p> <p>⇒ Foreign competitors who are underage in their country must be in possession of their signed accountability document (see attached). This document authorises underage competitors to take part in the competition and needs to be handed in during registration.</p>
<b>6.3 Coach</b>	<p>⇒ Free entry for 1 coach with a maximum of 5 competitors.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- 1 to 5 competitors: 1 coach</li> <li>- 6 to 10 competitors: 2 coaches</li> <li>- 11 to 15 competitors: 3 coaches</li> <li>- ...</li> </ul> <p>⇒ 5 € fee per additional coach.</p> <p>⇒ Coaches must wear sporting attire.</p> <p>⇒ Coaches must be at least 18 years old.</p> <p>⇒ Coaches must be in possession of their ID card or passport.</p> <p>⇒ All BTF-affiliated (ABFT-TVDSG-VTB) coaches must be in possession of their Coach card.</p> <p>⇒ Coaches must be in possession of their 2020 license/insurance.</p>
<b>6.4 First Aid</b>	A doctor will be in attendance throughout the competition.



<b>6.5 Protectors</b>	⇒ WT-recognised protectors are mandatory for all categories (head protector, mouthguard, forearm protectors, shin protectors, groin guard, foot protectors), including categories where head kicks are not allowed.
<b>6.6 Protests</b>	Challenges to a referee's decision can only be made by the Head Coach immediately after the end of a fight. The coach will need to fill out the appropriate form provided by the organiser, subject to a 50 € fee per challenge. The fee will be reimbursed in the event that the challenge is granted to the coach. The Referee Chairman's decision will be the only one deemed as valid.
<b>6.7 Organiser's responsibility</b>	The organizing club declines all responsibility if a competitor is alone in their category Friendly fixtures can be organized if they are authorized by the referees and the organiser No reimbursement will be made

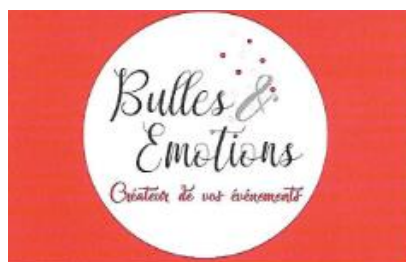
## 7 Registration

<b>7.1 Registration Deadline</b>	⇒ No registration will be permitted after <b>19/04/2020</b> ⇒ No registration will be permitted on the day of the competition
<b>7.2 Online Registration</b> 	Registration can only be made through <a href="http://www.martial.events">www.martial.events</a> <b>Note :</b> Contestants are not allowed to compete in more than one weight division on the same day.
<b>7.3 Competitors Number</b>	<b>A maximum of 420 entries</b> will be accepted for this competition.
<b>7.4 Registration Fee</b>	For each competitor: - 25 € for Pee wees - 25 € for C-class cadets - 30 € for A/B-class cadets - 35 € for Juniors - 35 € for Seniors
<b>7.5 Payment</b>	⇒ Registration fees must be paid to the following account : - BE45 0688 9639 2989 - <b>ATTENTION : NOT THE SAME ACCOUNT AS THE POOMSAE COMPETITION</b> - Before 19/04/2020 - Communication : « number of competitors + (team name) »  ⇒ If the entry limit is reached before the deadline for payment, the organiser may reserve the right to request pending payment as well as to remove competitors whose entry fee has not be paid in full. ⇒ Proof of payment must be provided on registration day. ⇒ Payment on the day of the competition will not be allowed ⇒ Competitors who have not been unregistered before the registration deadline will not be reimbursed.

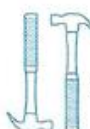
