6 RESPONSIBILITY

6.2 Competitors	<ul> <li>⇒ All competitors must be in possession of their 2020 license and insurance</li> <li>⇒ All competitors must be in possession of a valid ID card or passport.</li> <li>⇒ All competitors enter the competition at their own risk.</li> <li>⇒ The organising club and ABFT decline any responsibility in the event of physical damage, violent behavior, injury or theft.</li> <li>⇒ Foreign competitors who are underage in their country must be in possession of their signed accountability document (see attached). This document authorises underage competitors to take part in the competition and needs to be handed in during registration.</li> </ul>
6.3 Coach	<ul> <li>⇒ Free entry for 1 coach with a maximum of 5 competitors.         <ul> <li>1 to 5 competitors: 1 coach</li> <li>6 to 10 competitors: 2 coaches</li> <li>11 to 15 competitors: 3 coaches</li> <li></li> </ul> </li> <li>⇒ 5 € fee per additional coach.</li> <li>⇒ Coaches must wear sporting attire.</li> <li>⇒ Coaches must be at least 18 years old.</li> <li>⇒ Coaches must be in possession of their ID card or passport.</li> <li>⇒ All BTF-affiliated (ABFT-TVDSG-VTB) coaches must be in possession of their Coach card.</li> <li>⇒ Coaches must be in possession of their 2020 license/insurance.</li> </ul>
6.4 First Aid	A doctor will be in attendance throughout the competition.

6.5 Protectors	⇒ WT-recognised protectors are mandatory for all categories (head protector, mouthguard, forearm protectors, shin protectors, groin guard, foot protectors), including categories where head kicks are not allowed.
6.6 Protests	Challenges to a referee's decision can only be made by the Head Coach immediately after the end of a fight. The coach will need to fill out the appropriate form provided by the organiser, subject to a 50 € fee per challenge. The fee will be reimbursed in the event that the challenge is granted to the coach. The Referee Chairman's decision will be the only one deemed as valid.
6.7 Organiser's responsibility	The organizing club declines all responsibility if a competitor is alone in their category Friendly fixtures can be organized if they are authorized by the referees and the organiser No reimbursement will be made
